General Information

- Walkers must register on Walk Day. Please have forms completed, totaled, signed and donations in an envelope. Everything must be turned in by the start of the walk to be eligible for prizes.
- Walking is optional.
- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Owners are responsible for picking up their animal's waste—plastic baggies will be provided.
- The walk takes place rain or shine. The complete walk is 2.5-miles on a paved path that doubles back along the same route. Walkers can shorten their walk anytime by just turning around and returning to the park shelter.
- Free food and pop; water for both pets and people.
- Carpooling is highly recommended.
- All animals must be under the control of an adult. Please keep dogs on a short lead.
- **Have some fun!** Gather your family and friends and come dressed in hats, matching shirts or full costumes to signify your group. Be creative and make a statement!

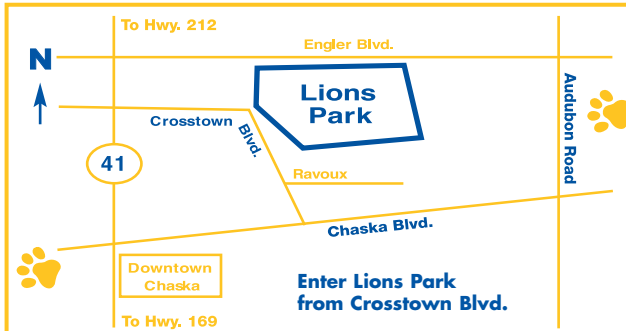
